Organizing Authority: Fleet 95 of Division 4 of the Hobie Class Assn. of North America.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing as well as relevant class rules.

Eligibility & Entry: The regatta is open to class legal Hobie Wave, 14, 16, 17, 18, F18 (Tiger & Wildcat) and 20s. Five entries constitute a one-design class. All skippers must be 2017 HCA-NA members.

Sailing Instructions: Available at registration.

Venue: Columbia River between Skamokawa Vista Park and Astoria, OR.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall have current 3rd party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of not less than \$100,000.

Lodging: Camping is available at Skamokawa Vista Park (for a fee). Skamokawa Inn, a local B&B is also available.
