NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Hobie Class Rules apply and are available at: <https://hobieclass.com/class-rules/>

2. Sailing Instructions: Will be available at onsite registration.

3. Communication:

- 3.1. The official Notice Board is located at the campground shelter.
- 3.2. Boats may carry VHF radios, however, while racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. Eligibility and Entry:

- 4.1 This event is open to all Hobie classes.
- 4.2 HCANA membership is required (one per boat, or one Single Regatta Fee). **Due to limited internet access onsite, please Join, Renew, or pay the Single Regatta Fee now at [HCANA](#) or hobiediv4.org. Please bring a receipt to registration.**
- 4.3 Boat inspection and a \$20 Permit Sticker is required for all boats prior to launch. This is processed by the Rain Forest Resort and is to protect Lake Quinault. Stickers enforced by the Quinault Nation.
- 4.4 Eligible boats may register online using Credit Card, once online registration is open. Watch for notice in email and social media or visit hobiediv4.org for links. This option may be closed several days prior to the event.
- 4.5 Eligible boats may also enter by completing the entry form onsite at registration and paying all fees via US Check or US dollars. Credit Cards cannot be processed onsite.

5. Fees: Entry fees are- Single Handed: \$40 Double Handed: \$50 Youth Team: 50% Discount All Youth (Single or both Double Handed) must be under 26 at the time of the event

7. Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000 per incident or the equivalent.
